# New Fundraising targets

Now that the adventure play ground is paid we have received a new "wish list" from Mrs Perry and her team.

On the list is funding new educational play equipment for the Year 1 play area at a cost of £5,000.

After the school having invested in new computers for the IT suite, the room itself and the furniture in it is in need of a revamp. That is estimated to cost £17,000.

On one of the walls by the year 6 area we are raising funds to put up two distortion mirrors. The mirrors cost £450 each.
