CPD for staff	PE leader teaches alongside class teachers across the school, teaching whole units of work. Class teachers and the PE leader discuss areas they would like to develop beforehand. Class teachers then observe, support and teach part of the lessons themselves, using ideas, techniques and strategies from previous lessons.	£17,201.67	- Teachers have a greater confidence when delivering PE and have increased their subject knowledge. Teachers have described how they have a better understanding of how to develop skills through a unit of work and demonstrate specific skills. They are more confident delivering specific skills e.g.: forward rolls and hockey stick handling - PE leader was able to network and gain ideas for PE provision for next academic year.
